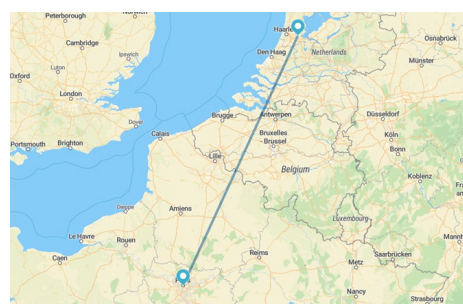

Paris and Amsterdam by train

And its attractions are countless: 137 museums such as the Louvre, the Orsay or the Pompidou; beautiful temples such as the Cathedral of Notre Dame or the Royal Basilica of Saint Denis; urban parks such as the Jardin des Tuileries; hidden treasures like its 300 kilometers of catacombs; and, of course, the Champs-Élysées, the Arc de Triomphe and the mythical Eiffel Tower, from where you can admire unparalleled views. We also recommend a visit to Versailles, 22 kilometers west of Paris to discover its grandiose Palace where the famous Marie Antoinette roamed. Paris awaits you so that you can also breathe its "bon vivant" spirit and enjoy the pleasures of life, perhaps sitting at the table of one of its 8,000 terrace cafes, or of its typical bistros, or of its elegant restaurants of fame. international.



The next stage of the trip is

Amsterdam, a city designed for walking, because with the exception of bicycles and trams there is hardly any traffic. The capital of the Netherlands perfectly combines its modern and cosmopolitan airs with an incomparable historical atmosphere, being for decades one of the most tourist cities in the world. A must visit are the Rijksmuseum, with Rembrandt's works as an essential element, the Van Gogh Museum, which exhibits part of the post-impressionist legacy of the famous painter, and the Anne Frank house, the house where the young Jewish woman hid from Nazi persecution. . Also enjoy the unmistakable beauty of its canals full of boats or visit the manicured parks that dot the entire city, where lively markets are held. Spend seven days between Paris and Amsterdam, two true world capitals of art, culture ... and leisure.

Important remarks

- Triple rooms in Europe are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- To avoid queues and crowds, you can book tickets to the most outstanding museums and exhibition halls online and in advance. We recommend trying to visit the museums early in the morning or in the afternoon. To obtain discounts on tickets and save yourself from having to queue, you can purchase cards such as the Holland Pass, the Museumkaart, the I Amsterdam City Card or the Rotterdam Welcome Card. Many museums offer special discounts for minors, students and pensioners.
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Hotels usually have cots available. Otherwise, babies will have to share a bed with an adult.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
