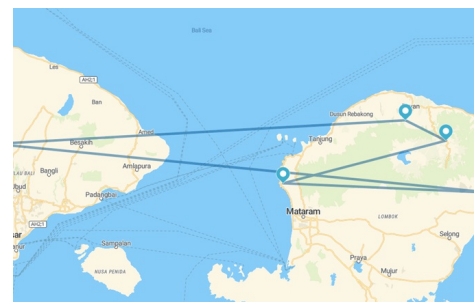
Lombok Island and South Bali Beaches

Travel details

● DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - BALI ISLAND

Day 1: Departure with destination Bali Island. Night on board.

● DAY 2 · BALI ISLAND

Day 2: Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Bali Island. Free time. Overnight stay.

● DAY 3 · BALI ISLAND - LOMBOK CITY - LOMBOK - SENGGIGI

Day 3: At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport. Flight from Bali Island to Lombok City. Arrival and transfer to a local restaurant for lunch. Afterwards, we will depart for the Mayura Water Palace. On the other side of the road we will see the three tallest trees of the Meru Temple, representing Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva. Continue to the Lingsar Temple. According to legend, a sacred tuna lives in the waters of its pond. According to the locals, whoever catches a glimpse of this fish will receive good luck. The last visit will be to the Narmada Water Palace, built as a royal garden and place of veneration. Its main lake was planned as a replica of the Segara Anak Lake on Mount Rinjani. Arrival in Senggigi. Accommodation.

● DAY 4 · SENGGIGI – TETE BATU - SEMBALUN

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch

Day 4: Breakfast. Departure to the hills surrounding Tete Batu, the rice terrace at the foot of the giant Mount Rinjani. On arrival, we will take a walk through the villages of Tete Batu and Loyok. There we will start a light trekking, during which we will see black monkeys, mahogany trees and clove and vanilla plantations. Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the starting point where we will take the road back to Sembalun. Through rice fields, villages, hills and forests we will reach the Pusuk Pass, a high point from where we will see Sembalun. Arrival in Sembalun. Accommodation.

● DAY 5 · SEMBALUN – LAWANG – BAMBUNG - SENARU

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch

Day 5: Breakfast. We start our visits in the Sasak villages of Lawang and Bambang. The Sasak are related to the Balinese by language and ancestry, although they are mostly Muslim. Perhaps, if circumstances permit, we can visit the abandoned village of Beleq. Continue to Senaru, where we will see two of the most impressive waterfalls in Lombok: Sendang Gile and Tiu Kelep. We will reach them after a light trekking. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit the village before going to the hotel. Accommodation

● DAY 6 · SENARU - LOMBOK - BALI ISLAND

Includes : Breakfast

Day 6: Breakfast. Free time until transfer time. Flight from Lombok City to Bali Island. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Bali Island. Free time. Overnight stay.

● DAYS 7-8 · BALI ISLAND

Days 7-8: Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 9 · BALI ISLAND - CITY OF ORIGIN

Day 9: At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

Important remarks

- Triple rooms in Indonesia are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- The baggage allowance on domestic flights of most airlines in India is usually 15 kg per person, so lower than on international flights. Please take account of this when packing your bags.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Indonesia.
- Indonesia is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- Depending on the return flight, the trip may be one day longer.
- To reconfirm services at the destination, please send us your passport details within 24 hours of booking.

- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Children up to 11 years old will not have their own bed or cot, so they will sleep in the bed provided with the adults.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.

- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
