



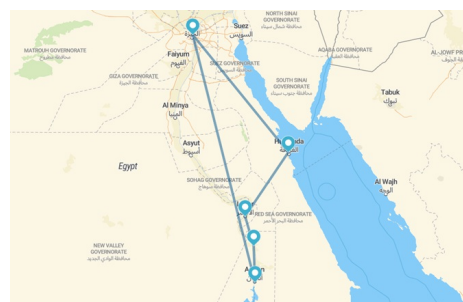

DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - CAIRO

Day 1: Departure with destination Cairo. Arrival and assistance. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAYS 2-3 · CAIRO

Includes : Breakfast - Breakfast

Day 2: Breakfast. Departure for a visit to the pyramid complex of Khafre, Cheops, and Menkaure (entrance not included), the Great Sphinx, and the Valley Temple. Next, visit the new Grand Egyptian Museum (the tour will be self-guided, although guests have the option of hiring an audio guide at their own expense). Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Breakfast. Free day with the option to explore Cairo at your leisure or book optional tours. Overnight in Cairo.

DAY 4 · CAIRO - ASWAN

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 4: Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Aswan. Arrival and transfer to the motor vessel. Dinner and overnight on board.

DAY 5 · ASWAN - KOM OMBO - EDFU

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 5: Breakfast. Free morning with an optional visit to Abu Simbel. Then, a faluka (sailboat) ride and a visit to Egypt's largest dam, vital to the country's development. Lunch on board. Sail to Kom Ombo. In the afternoon, visit the Kom Ombo temple, which houses important information about ancient medicine and political society. Dinner on board. Sail to Edfu. Overnight on board.

● DAY 6 · EDFU - LUXOR

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 6: Breakfast. Visit to the Temple of Horus, one of the best preserved in Egypt. Lunch on board. Sail to Luxor. In the afternoon, depart to visit the temples of Luxor and Karnak, one of the largest in the world. Dinner and overnight on board.

● DAY 7 · LUXOR - HURGHADA

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 7: Breakfast. Departure for the following visits: the Valley of the Kings, the Habu Medinet Temple, and the Colossi of Menmon. Finally, transfer by road to Hurghada. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay and dinner.

● DAYS 8-10 · HURGHADA

Days 8-10: All-inclusive stay. Free time with the possibility of optional visits (not included). Accommodation.

Important remarks

- Egypt is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- The tours include cultural stops at local workshops so you can learn about the production of traditional crafts.
- Mandatory payments and optional excursions are payable in cash once in Egypt.
- Triple rooms in Africa are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Check-in at hotels starts at 12 p.m.
- Mandatory payments at the destination (service fee and/or general tips) must be paid in cash.
- The published itinerary is for arrivals at the destination on Tuesdays. For arrivals on other days of the week, please inquire.
- Nile Motorboats: The category we publish corresponds to the official categorization of the Egyptian Ministry of Tourism. However, in most cases, this category does not meet European quality standards.
- The Egyptian authorities have officially announced that the new Grand Egyptian Museum will remain closed from October 15 to November 3, due to construction needs and internal logistical issues. Therefore, during this period, the visit will be replaced by an excursion to the Open-Air Museum of Memphis.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
